IceWorld Ice Rental Statement for August 12, 2020

After extensive review and consultation with local and state health officials, City of Boise and Parks and Recreation Department leaders have made the decision to allow ice rentals at Idaho IceWorld to begin on Friday, July 10. Meanwhile, all lessons, classes, tournaments and programming outside of ice rentals remain on hold due to Ada County's move back to Stage 3 of the Idaho Rebounds plan. Please keep in mind that Idaho IceWorld has implemented new health and safety protocols throughout the facility due to the coronavirus (COVID-19) and its continued spread in our community. In addition, due to the updated Central District Health public health order that took effect in the City of Boise on August 11<sup>th</sup>, all Idaho IceWorld users will be required to wear a mask that covers their nose and mouth when inside the facility, with the exception of when they are actively engaged in athletic competition, training, or practice within the confines of the ice surface. Coaches, instructors, spectators, and participants not within the confines of the playing surface shall be required to wear a mask.

Your health and safety plan must be submitted to Boise Parks and Recreation via the Idaho IceWorld website before your scheduled rental time. Plans can be submitted on behalf of a league or group by a spokesperson or representative for the overall organization. Please make this clear in your submission.

All leagues, groups, individuals and teams are expected to design their safe play protocols to match or exceed the following recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Central District Health (CDH). Additional guidance from your professional sport organizations and leagues should also be considered.
